Every week they provide a nutritious meal, but they do not stop there! They have a speaker or local organization join us with helpful information and Services. In the past some of these services have included: Eye Screenings, Health Checks (blood pressure, diabetics, flu shots etc.), financial planning, Department of Human Services in MS, and Oxford Food Pantry.

They also have Arts and Crafts for the kids, Musical Entertainment (provided by local artists) and Puppet shows. In addition there is tutoring for children or just helping them with homework and Playing with kids outside.

Every other Tuesday they give out toiletries (paper towels, toilet paper, soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, body wash) just to name a few, and diapers for people with babies. There is also a small Library for kids and adults to pick out books to take home.

meal and serve that meal, assisted by volunteers from their organization. Most Churches and Organizations sign up for 1 Tuesday in the fall and 1 Tuesday in the spring. If there is any remaining food, it is put into to-go boxes for people to take home. Also, several Ole Miss Sororities provide additional food for the to-go boxes.

In addition to these services,

each year they provide coats for kids (new not used), Christmas gifts for all the kids, and gift cards for the adults.

There is a local knitting group that knits hats for everyone, all sizes, designs, and colors.

Other organizations and groups in the community will do things like, art prints for everybody and Easter baskets for the kids just to name a few things.

Just my personal side note: They don’t just serve the meals, they decorate the tables every week; and when there is a holiday, they decorate for that holiday, and do a little extra. They don’t just serve, they will hang out, sit and talk, and get to know you. It’s up to each group what food they want to serve. So the meals are very diverse from fried chicken, BBQ, spaghetti, lasagna, and all the sides for each meal. My fave is when we grill burgers and hotdogs.
